



Green Business Co-operation Day

Brief Introduction

To further promote business co-operation in the environmental sector, the Green Business Co-operation Day (Green Business Day) and a series of activities will be held in the afternoon of 8 April, the first day of International Environmental Co-operation Forum and Exhibition (MIECF). Enterprise Green Business Summit, networking cocktail reception and contract signing ceremony will be held to assist enterprises to make the most of valuable green business opportunities and search for potential partners for project and economic co-operation.

Organisers of the Green Business Day include various trade and economic organisations, government departments and chambers of commerce, such as the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade (CCPIT) and the Macao Trade and Investment Promotion Institute (IPIM). It is aimed at integrating the networks and size of Mainland, Macao and overseas trade and economic organisations and chambers of commerce, to enhance the level of business co-operation activities.

The Green Business Co-operation Symposium and Green Business Summit will enable enterprise and organisation representatives from the environmental and financial sectors from various regions to conduct in-depth discussions on environmental development projects, current and future developments in green financing, as well as discussing strategies for environmental co-operation development between enterprises.

Project-matching, green business co-operation networking, a cocktail reception and contract-signing ceremony will also be arranged during the Green Business Day to provide networking and business negotiation opportunities for enterprises from different regions, to further enhance the co-operation between environmental sectors from Macao, Mainland and overseas enterprises (particularly those in the Pan-Pearl River Delta area and the European Union).

Green Business Co-operation Day enables enterprises' and investors' exchanges and co-operation to seize potential green opportunities.
